

Admission Requirements

Admission is open to any qualified applicant. Active Health Institute is an equal opportunity/affirmative action institution and does not discriminate on the basis of race, color, religion, sex, age, national origin, or handicap status in its educational programs, activities, hiring, or student admission practices. Active Health Institute complies with Title IX of the Education Amendments of 1972 and the regulations in Title VI and VII of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973, and the Age Discrimination Act of 1973.

Applicants must be 18 years of age or older to apply. If under the age of 18 at the time of enrollment, a parent or guardian must enroll the applicant. Students must be 18 years of age at the time of graduation.

1. The applicant should present evidence of high school diploma, high school certification, equivalent documentation, or GED.
2. Prospective students must be beyond the age of compulsory education (18 years old) at the time of graduation.
3. For students who are 17 years of age or under, a parent or legal guardian must also sign the Enrollment Agreement.
4. Submission of a completed application
5. Pay all fees required for enrollment.

Additional Admission requirements for Nursing Program:

The following data will be utilized by the admissions department in evaluating the qualifications of candidates for admission:

1. Completion of entrance examination with a minimum passing score of 70%.
2. Interview with the Director of Nursing or designee.
3. Two professional letters of recommendation. Letters of recommendation should include contact information.
4. Transfer Credit - Official college transcripts for all colleges attended and for all courses taken for transfer Must have an overall GPA of 2.6 or higher on a 4.0 to be considered for transfer
5. Employment Verification
6. Pay all fees required for enrollment.
