

Entrance Requirements for the Bachelor of Science in Nursing (RN-to-BSN) Program:

Admission Requirements Admission is open to any qualified applicant. Active Health Institute is an equal opportunity/affirmative action institution and does not discriminate on the basis of race, color, religion, sex, age, national origin, or handicap status in its educational programs, activities, hiring, or student admission practices. Active Health Institute complies with Title IX of the Education Amendments of 1972 and the regulations in Title VI and VII of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973, and the Age Discrimination Act of 1973.

Applicants must be 18 years of age or older to apply. If under the age of 18 at the time of enrollment, a parent or guardian must enroll the applicant. Students must be 18 years of age at the time of graduation.

Entrance Requirements:

1. The applicant should present evidence of high school diploma, high school certification, equivalent documentation, or GED.
2. Prospective students must be beyond the age of compulsory education (18 years old) at the time of graduation.
3. For students who are 17 years of age or under, a parent or legal guardian must also sign the Enrollment Agreement.
4. Submission of a completed application
5. Pay all fees required for enrollment.

The following data is required, and will be utilized by the admissions department in evaluating the qualifications of candidates for admission:

1. Applicants must have an active unencumbered Florida registered nurse license.
2. Evidence of an AA or AS conferred degree with a minimum of 60 semester credits and fifteen general education credits.
3. Completion of entrance examination with a minimum passing score of 70%.
4. Interview with the Director of Nursing or designee.
5. Two professional letters of recommendation. Letters of recommendation should include contact information.
6. *Transfer Credit - Official college transcripts for all colleges attended and for all courses taken for transfer Must have an overall GPA of 2.6 or higher on a 4.0 to be considered for transfer.
7. Employment Verification (If applicable)

The following are not required for admission into the RN to BSN program, however, must be completed and show evidence indicating completion prior to the first semester ends or prior to clinical courses; whichever comes first:

1. Successful completion of the physical examination form and specific laboratory test, including CBC, urinalysis, PPD test (if positive, chest X-rays are required), Rubella, Varicella and Rubella titers.
2. Criminal background check, finger printing, and a drug screen. The applicant will incur the expense of the physical exam and lab test.
3. Evidence of Hepatitis B vaccine or declination.
4. Active CPR certification completed by the first day of school and remaining in effect until graduation
